Congratulations! Your child now has access to Señor Woolly, the most exciting and comprehensive Spanish language acquisition website available!

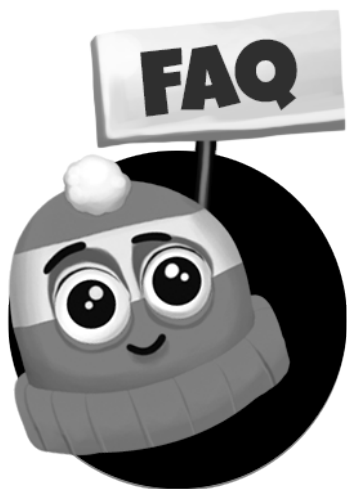
What makes this program different from other language learning apps and websites? With Señor Woolly, students don't learn Spanish. They *acquire* it via musical stories.

Q) What are "Nuggets"?

Nuggets are gamified language activities that recycle the language from the videos in new and unique ways in order to promote Spanish acquisition. Completing a single Nugget usually takes between 5 and 15 minutes.
